Sir/Madam,

I would like to mention that the Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad Foundation and MIT School of Government, Pune have been bringing together students from across the Country in an annual conclave called Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad (Indian Students' Parliament). Twelve (12) such annual events have already been organized with great success. The **13th Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad** is being organized for three days from 10th to 12th January 2024 at MIT World Peace University, Pune. The basic objective of organizing this conclave is to effectively involve the youth in the democratic process of the country. The event is supported by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, Ministry of Higher & Technical Education, Maharashtra, AIU, AICTE. It also gets support/participation from international agencies like UN, UNESCO, SAARC, Inter-Parliamentary Union, and the Commonwealth.

2. This is a non-partisan and apolitical event, where deliberations are held on issues of contemporary significance. During the last 12 years, several eminent personalities have addressed the conclave like: Late Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Late Shri Pranab Mukherjee, Smt. Pratibha Patil etc. In addition to these, several eminent personalities like H.E. Aung San Suu Kyi, Irina Bokova, Malala Yousafzai, and Sunita Williams etc., addressed the conclave through pre-recorded video messages.

3. During the 13th Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad, scheduled to be held from 10 to 12 January 2024, deliberations will take place on a number of important subjects like (i) Youth Leadership in Politics – Rhetoric or Reality (ii) Yugaantar – Youth in Transition (iii) Democracy 2.0 – How AI and Social Media are changing the game (iv) Power of Folklore in our culture (v) Data, Diversity and Democracy – Cast Census Dilemma (vi) As we Land on Moon, are Women Safe on Land. 4. Indian Students' Parliament plays a significant role in reshaping the perspective of young individuals and reinforcing their reverence for democracy and its establishments. 
- Provide a platform for young people to develop their leadership skills and engage with social cause.
