



## The main features of the programme are:

All Bachelor's Degree programmes are fulltime regular for the specified duration as per National Education Policy (NEP-2020) with Multiple Exit and Entry systems at various stages after Even semesters from the academic session 2022, and onwards.

As per the UGC Guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exit in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education Institutions, candidates who secure a minimum CGPA of 7.5 in a three-year Bachelor's Degree Programme shall be allowed to continue studies in the fourth year of the undergraduate programme to pursue and complete the Bachelor's Degree with Research/ Honours.

For admission reservation policy shall be implemented as per S.R.O. 127 dated: 20-04-2020 read with S.R.O. 249 dated: the 3-07-2021. Selection of the candidates from the reserved categories shall be made strictly based on academic merit and validity of respective reserved category certificates as the case may be. No under-process certificate shall be accepted.

#### **Mode of Admission**

- A. The selection of candidates for admission to Bachelors Programme shall be made through CUET conducted by the NTA as well as in the Non CUET mode.
- B. Candidates shall ensure to obtain the

ABC ID from the Academic Bank of Credits Portal by registering on the portal making use of their Aadhaar linked mobile numbers and enter the 12 digit ABC id on their online Admission forms in order to avail the mobility options under Academic Bank of Credits.

National Testing Agency has been mandated by the Ministry of Education and UGC to conduct Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission into Undergraduate Programmes. CUET (UG) will provide a single window opportunity to students seeking across the Country.

# Course Structure and Credit Distribution:

Subject to changes from time to time by the competent Bodies of the University:

Every student shall opt for Two Disciplines of his/her choice (One as a Major and One as a Minor or both as Major - Dual Major) from the same stream based on interest and eligibility. These two subjects shall form a common thread from 1st to the 8th Semester of the Programme for every student.

In case of a single major a student shall have a requirement of earning at least 80 credits for a Four- Year Under-Graduate Programme (FYUGP)/60 credits for a Three-Year Under-Graduate Programme (TYUGP).





Every student shall also have to earn a minimum of 32 credits in the minor subject in FYUGP and 24 Credits in a TYUGP.

In case of a dual major a student shall have a requirement of earning at least 64 credits in each Major for a Four-Year Under-Graduate Programme (FYUGP) / 48 credits in each Major fora Three-Year Under-Graduate Programme (TYUGP).

In addition to the Major & Minor subjects every student shall have to opt for a 3-credit Multi-disciplinary course in each of the 1st three semesters, which shall be different in different semesters with the following conditions; that a student should not have: i) opted such a course as a Major/Minor; and ii) studied such a course at the +2 level.

Besides, every student shall have to opt for one common Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) of 3 credits in each of the 1st three semesters comprising Communication Skills, English Language and any one of the Modern Indian Languages [MIL].

Additionally, each student has to complete the requirement of opting for the four Value Added Courses (VACs) of 2 credit each including Environmental Science/Education, Health and Wellness, Understanding India and Digital & Technological Solutions in the first two semesters.

Besides, one Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) of a total of 12 Credits shall also be required to be completed in the first three semesters, with a breakup of 4 credits in each semester.

The students choosing one Major and one Minor Subject shall have a flexibility of swapping the Major and Minor Subjects in 3rd Semester, subject to availability and eligibility to be determined by the college. However, if a student selects a Minor Subject, not being offered as a Major Subject, he/she shall not have this flexibility.

After 3rd Semester every student shall be required to earn either 16 credits of major and 4 credits of minor or 10 credits for each of the two majors up to 8th semester.

In case there is any change in the Course Structure or Credit Distribution or any other change as may be prescribed from time to time by the competent bodies of the affiliating University, the same may become part of these statutes in the form of regulation (s).

#### **Promotion**

Subject to the provisions of the statutes and regulations, promotion to the next higher semester/level shall be open to: -

From 1st semester to 4th semester (Level 5 & Level 6) after admission to 1st/3rd Semester (Level 5/6), in case he/she has fulfilled the statutory requirement of attendance and has passed the internal assessment of the preceding semester; from 4th semester to 8th semester (Level 7 to Level 8) in case he/she has fulfilled the statutory requirement of attendance, has passed the Internal Assessment component of the preceding semesters and has earned 50% credits of first three and 1stfive semesters for admission to 5th and 7th semesters (Level 7 & Level 8) respectively.

From the 4th Semester to the 5th Semester (Level 6 to Level 7) in case he/she has not a backlog of more than 50% credits of study in the 1st three semesters and from the 6th Semester to 7th Semester (Level 7 to Level 8) in case he/she has not a backlog of more than 50% credits of study in the first five Semesters.

A candidate who is short of attendance in a particular course of a semester in physical (face to face) mode shall not be allowed to sit in the examination of that course. However, he/she shall not be debarred from joining the next semester, if otherwise eligible under rules, subject to the condition that such a









candidate has to make up the deficiency in the concerned subject simultaneously.

The class work for the subsequent semester/s shall commence immediately after the culmination of the Semester-end examination/s without waiting for the completion of formal admission process for the subsequent semester/s, which for the subsequent odd semester/s shall be completed simultaneously without any compromise on the ongoing class work.

#### **Exit and Re-entry Policy:**

Any student admitted to the UGP shall have the option to Exit after completion of one, two, or three academic years and earning of a minimum of 40, 80 or 120 Credits respectively with a Certificate, Diploma, or Three-Year Graduation respectively, subject to the condition that he/she earns the required skill credits, prescribed by the University Statute/ Regulations.

The student has the option of Re-entry into the programme at a subsequent session, within 3 years of exit, as per the academic calendar with the condition that the entire FYUGP is completed within a maximum period of 7 years, as the shelf life of any earned credits is only 7 years.

Provided such students, whose shelf life of some credits has expired, shall be required to appear in the examination for such courses afresh.

#### **COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS**

#### **Physical Education**

The college has a well-established Physical Education Department to cater to the sports & athletic aspirations of its students. The department explores and nourishes the sports talent of the students and after proper training and coaching exposes them to high-level competitions. The department also helps talented sportspersons to participate in J&K and national level events.

The college has an ambitious plan to have a separate state of the art physical education block with all the latest sports equipment, in near future.

#### **Gymnasium**

The college is equipped with a state of Art Gymnasium for students to promote the fitness levels of students.

#### **Subject Tours Field Visits**

In addition to normal curricular activities, the college conducts subject tours/field works for the students as part of their practical training.

B.Com. /BBA/BCA/CA/B.Sc. IT students can go for industrial training for partial fulfilment of their project thesis.

#### **Debates/Seminars**

The committee conducts debates, seminars, workshops, drama, Science Exhibitions, Painting competitions etc. for students.

#### **NSS**

For rendering social services, the college has a NSS unit comprising of more than 100 volunteers. The unit is looked after by a dedicated NSS Program Officer. The NSS volunteers carry out activities of social utility such as environmental awareness programmes, Blood donation camps, cleanliness drives, anti-to-bacco awareness programmes and the like.

#### **Red Ribbon Club (NSS Unit)**

The college NSS unit stands registered member of Red Ribbon Club, which works under the banner of J&K AIDS Control and Prevention Society for AIDS free society.









#### **Road Safety Club**

The group conducts awareness programmes regarding road safety.

#### **Eco Club**

The club conducts awareness programmes regarding preservation of environment.

#### **Reading Club**

The Club conducts literary readings, discussions and writing competitions

#### **Class Rooms**

The college has about 18 classrooms equipped with latest Wifi enabled smart boards to impart quality education and is constantly upgrading and extending the facility. A multi-storey science block has recently been completed and thrown open for the use of students.

#### **Laboratories**

The college has science laboratories equipped with latest instruments for carrying out practical work. Computer laboratories for various science subjects.

#### **Financial Aid**

The College offers Financial Aid to students from less privileged backgrounds and facilitates scholarships like NSP and Child of Labourer registered with Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board (JK-BOCWWB).

#### **Transport Facility**

The College offers Bus Facility from Khrew Chowk to College via Kadlabal in the morning and evening.

#### **Music Club**

The College has an active Music Club where students conduct various musical activities.

#### **Library**

The college has a state-of-the-art central library, housed in a multi-story fire-safe building, fully automated and equipped with Surveillance and Intercom Systems. Presently, the college library houses 16672 books on different

streams like Science, Arts, Humanities, Commerce, Music, etc. The library houses a separate reference room with rich reference material like encyclopedias, directories, and dictionaries. history-books, literature, geographic collections, general knowledge, competitive examination books, civil services and UGC NET/SET, etc. A new section has also been introduced in the library for guidance and counselling for UPSC aspirants, civil services, UGC, Services selection boards and other competitive examinations with an adequate library basis and extensive resources both online and offline. The college library is automated with SOUL 3.0 software with a robust OPAC that helps library users to get instant information about the library resources.

Besides, the college subscribes to various magazines and periodicals for the latest information to keep students updated regarding current events happening in the world. The library also has a dedicated "Browsing Centre" with adequate high configuration of 30 latest desktops (AIO) and a high-end server, 62.5 KVA Diesel generator with BSNL Wi-Fi connectivity for academic excellence and best learning support, i.e. ONOS NLIST, NDLI, Open Educational Resources, Online resources, etc.

Students are encouraged to make use of SWAYAM, NPTEL, e-pgpatshala, e-gyaakosh, Vidyamitra, DIKSHA, MIT OCW, Openstax, Open Course Library, Saylor, Future-Learn, and other OER (Open Educational Resources). All these Open Educational Resources and links are provided under the Library Service menu on the college website. The College constitutes the library committee that decides and adopts policies to constantly upgrade its facilities and activities for the benefit of the student community. Moreover, the library takes an active part in organising literary and other allied activities regularly on its premises that help to sensitizes students on a wide range of achievements, issues and challenges of national and international importance.

The college has installed two water purifiers for pure and safe drinking water for the students. Pure and safe drinking water is available in the campus at various points in the institution where water purifiers are installed.

#### **Washrooms**

The college has sufficient number of washrooms for students in the departments and at various places adjacent to classrooms and laboratories in the campus. The College also has a separate disabled friendly washroom for students with special needs.

#### **Sports Infrastructure**

The college has latest equipment for both indoor as well as outdoor games. The college has a vast & beautiful playground for games like Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Hockey, Badminton & Kabbadi. Besides, a synthetic volleyball and basketball court has also been laid for the benefit of students. The college has a Mechanized Pitch Roller for maintaining the ground. The college has a state-of-the-art Gym with latest equipment for the benefit of the students.

#### **Continuous Power Supply**
