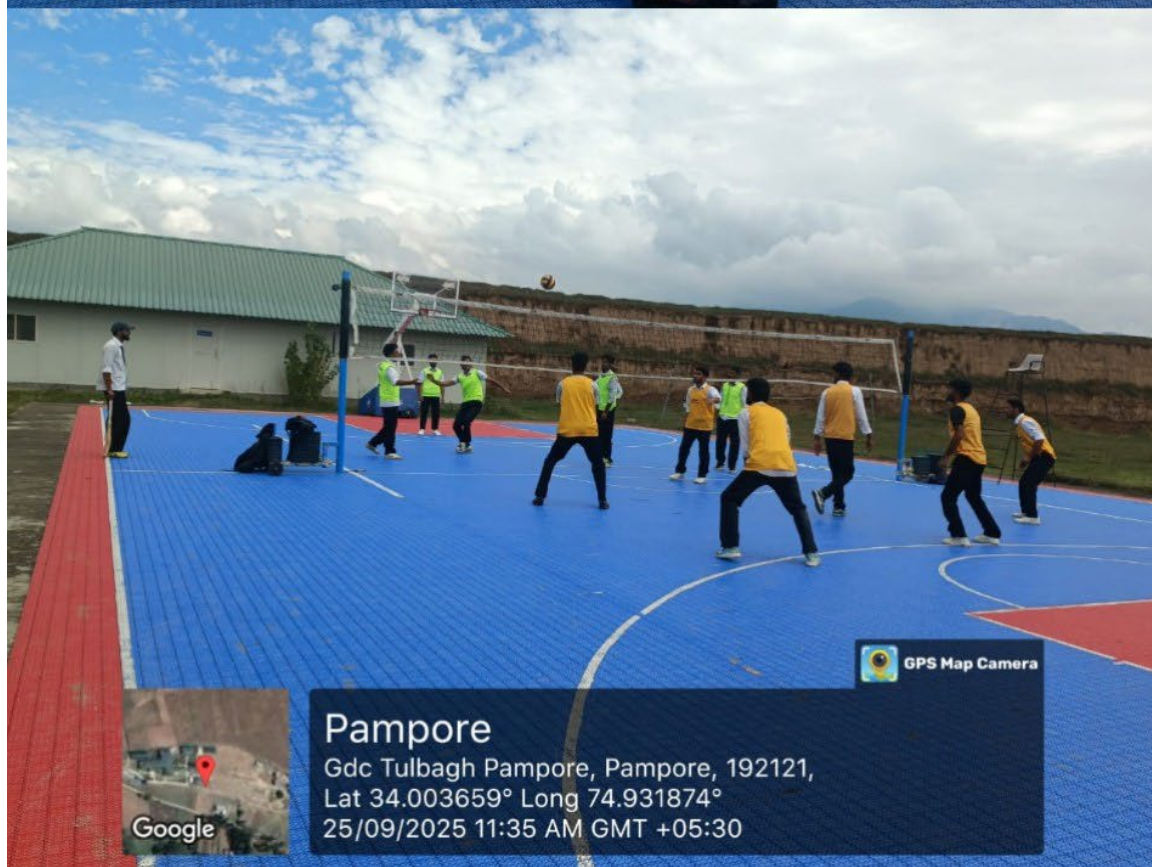
College Red Ribbon Club
