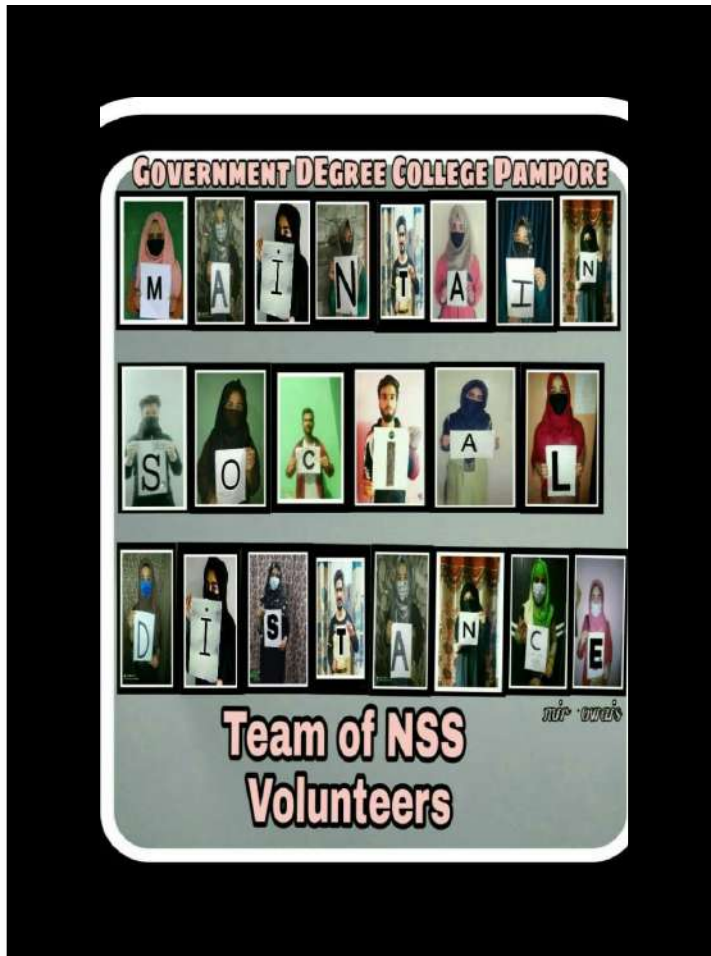

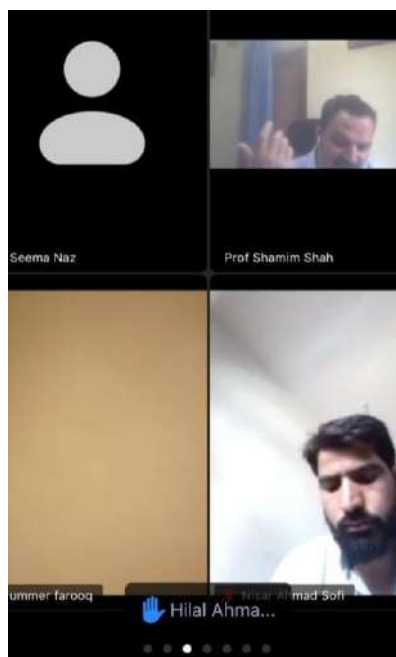

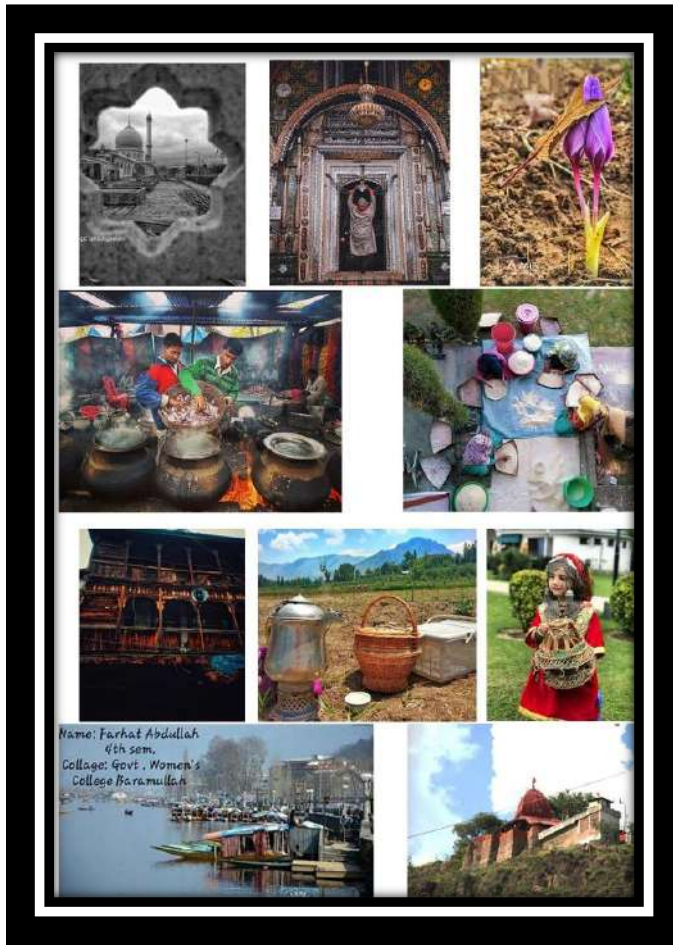

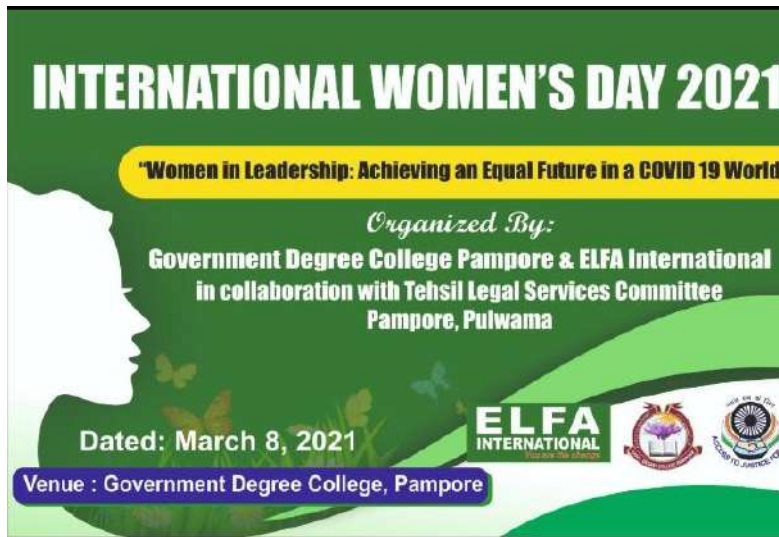


# MARCH, 2021

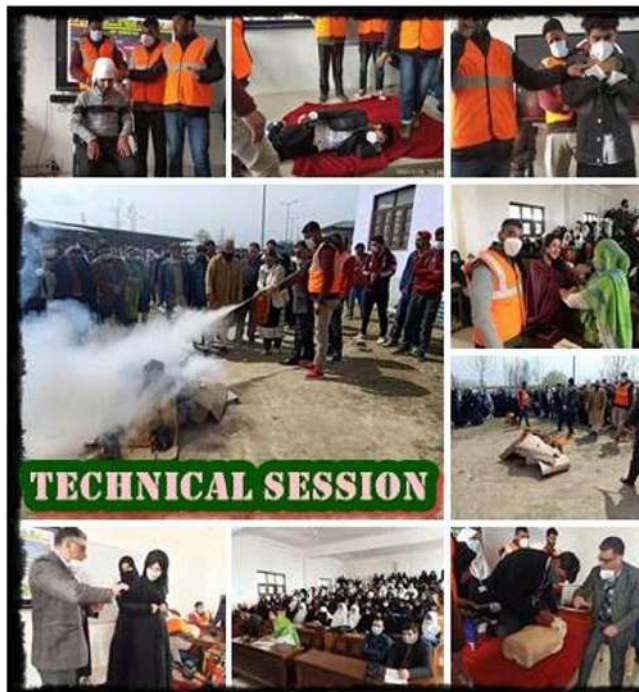


**5. Name of the Activity/Event:** One-Day Disaster Preparedness Training & Mock Drill

# Educational Visits

1. **Name of the Educational Visit:** Exposure Visit to Central Sericulture Research and Training Institute

**Dated:**

**About the Exposure Visit to Central Sericulture Research and Training Institute:**

Educational Visits are a part and parcel of an Educational Institute. It gives them an opportunity to learn from their own experiences and from the experience of others. One such visit was organized by the Department of Zoology, GDC Pampore to enable the students to learn new technologies evolved at the Central Sericulture Research & Training Institute in various aspects of Sericulture viz. techniques of propagation and maintenance of food-plants, silkworm rearing, seed production and production of silk and in turn apply those technologies for better performance in their sericulture activities in order to raise their income from sericulture and simultaneously enhance their standard of living.

An interactive session between the visited staff, students and CSR&TI staff marked the beginning of the exposure visit wherein, the students introduced themselves to the officials of visiting institute. The students shared their views and opinions about the course they have opted for their graduation.

The exposure visit started with an introductory note from the concerned officials of SCR&TI, Pampore. An audio visual presentation has been delivered by Dr. Rajesh Kumar (Scientist D) about geographical distribution and types of moth, types of host plants available with special reference to Kashmir.

The students lead by the CSR&TI staff were taken to scientific laboratories where different equipments and machines displayed to them with their mechanism of working and procedures during experimentation. These students were given live demonstrations of the equipments and have been taught their procedures to operate. Furthermore, live demonstration of different types of moths and their life cycle (growth stages) have been displayed to the visiting students by the scientist of CSR&TI Pampore. The equipments and machines that have been displayed to the students include:

1. Reeling Machines
2. Boiling Pan
3. Spinning Machine
4. Auto Clave etc.

Besides, different types of cocoons and their reeling, spinning and brushing procedures have been taught to them with live poster presentations available within the experimental laboratories.

After laboratory visit, the students have been taken to post cocoon unit wherein, they have been taught and shown live demonstrations regarding various post cocoon steps.

These steps include

1. Boiling of cocoon in boiling pan
2. Brushing of cocoon
3. Reeling of cocoon
4. Spinning of threads



## 5. Fiber making

The students were taken to fields where they were given physical demonstration of the hosts for sericulture which are available for cocoon formation and their processing to raw material for different sericulture techniques. Moreover, the students were given handy information about the latest developments by the research institute. The students have given a vision of sericulture as livelihood intervention with their market strategy and economic evaluation with respect to its cost benefit ratio.

The concluding remarks have been delivered by the course instructor of the Govt. Degree College Pampore namely **Dr. Tasfi Shafi (Zoologist)**. She on behalf of worthy Principal **Dr. Seema Naz (Psychologist)** thanked the administration of CSR&TI especially the worthy director for all the arrangements and hazel free atmosphere where students have learn lot of things about sericulture. She also thanked the scientists of CSR&TI Pampore for their cooperation and generous attitude towards the visiting staff and students. She advised the students to choose sericulture as their profession wherein they can excel and achieve the feat to fulfill their dream of becoming eminent scholars and entrepreneurs of the valley in particular and India as general.
