Celebration of 400th birth anniversary of Guru Teg Bahadur Ji

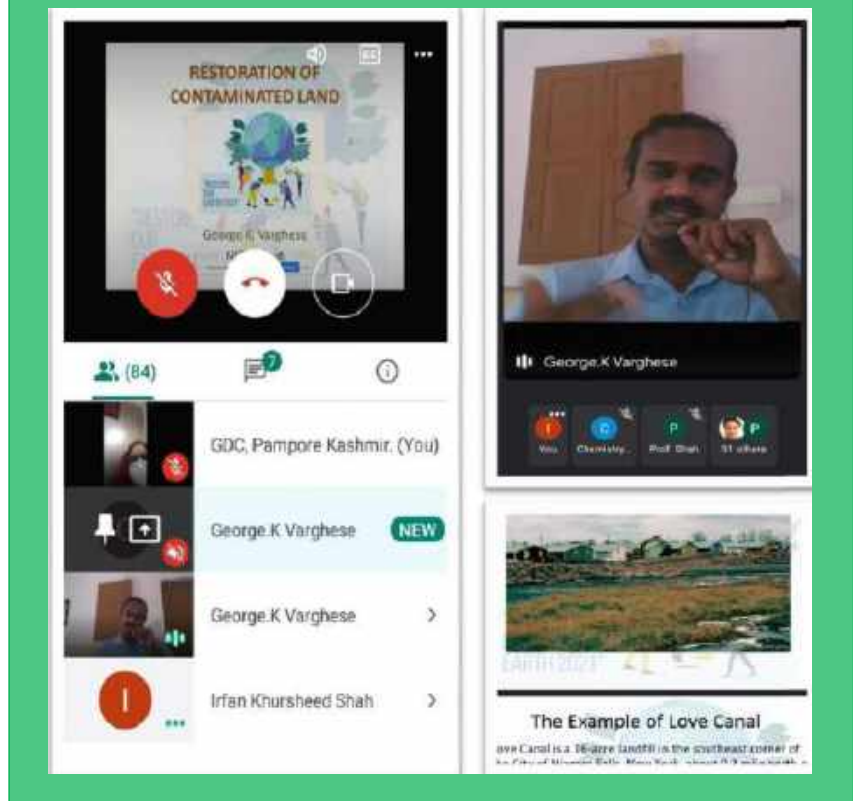
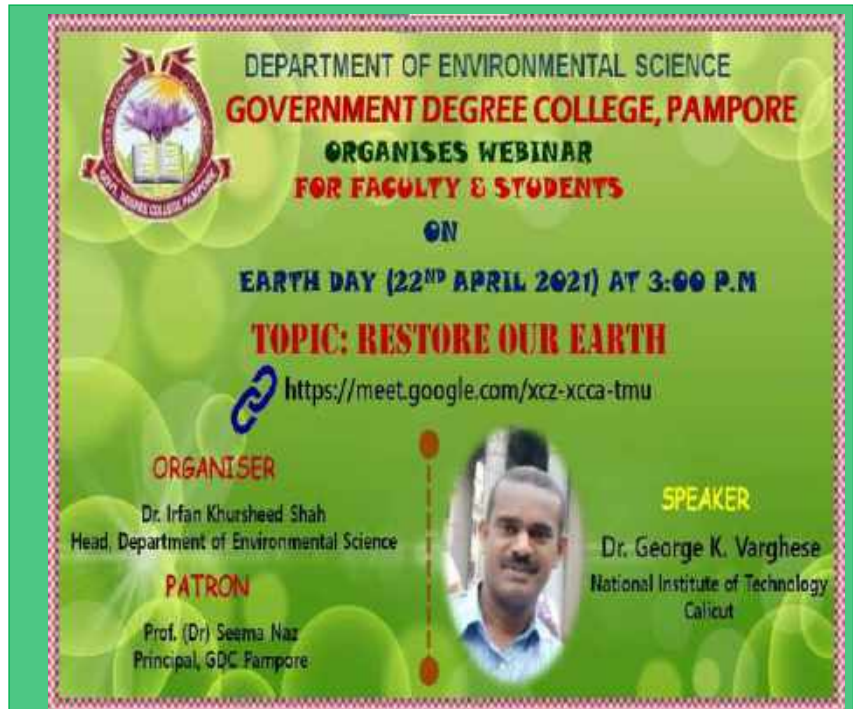

Department of EVS Celebrated Earth Day-2021

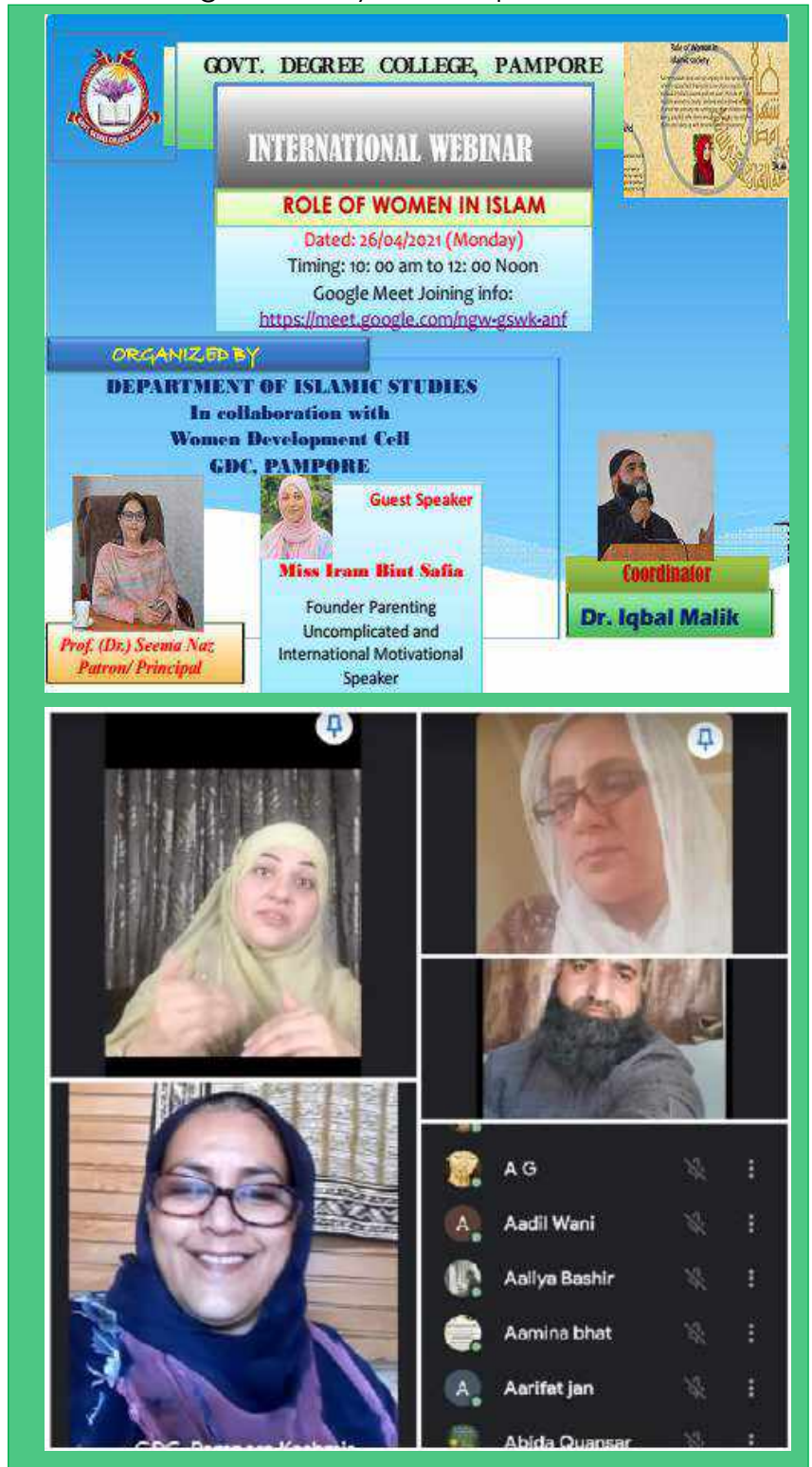

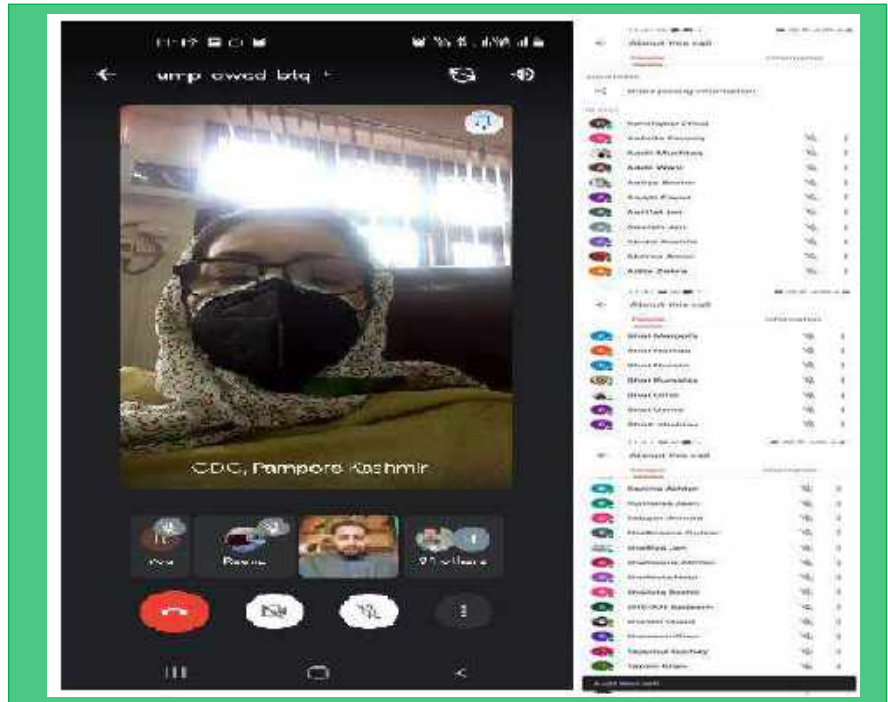


One day Online Seminar on Coping Stress amid COVID-19 “The Role of Teachers”.

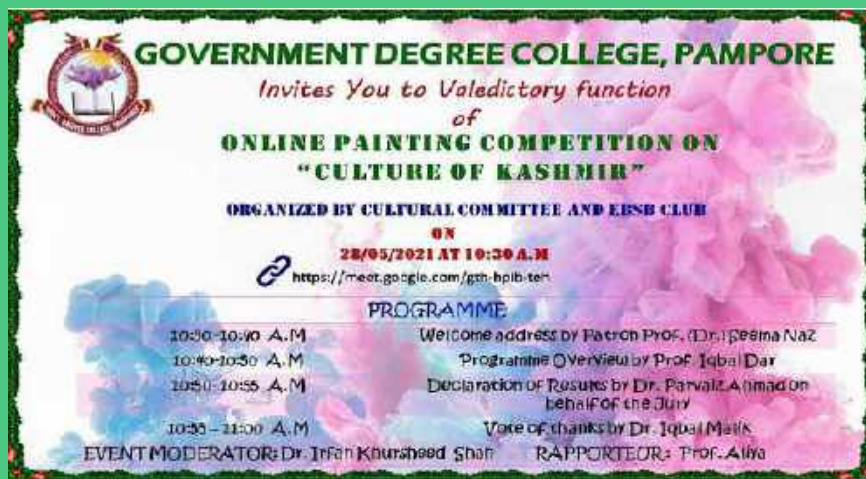


a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Irfan Khursheed Shah, Head Department of Environmental Science.

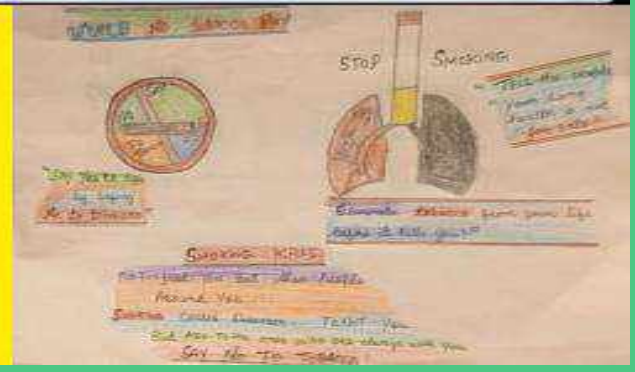

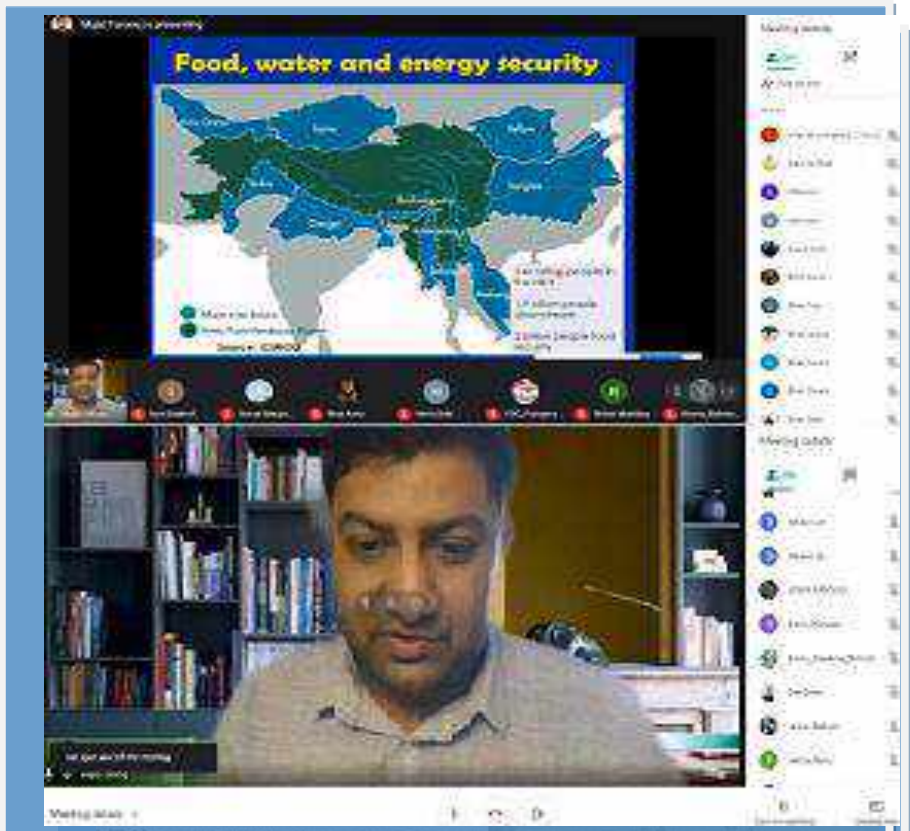

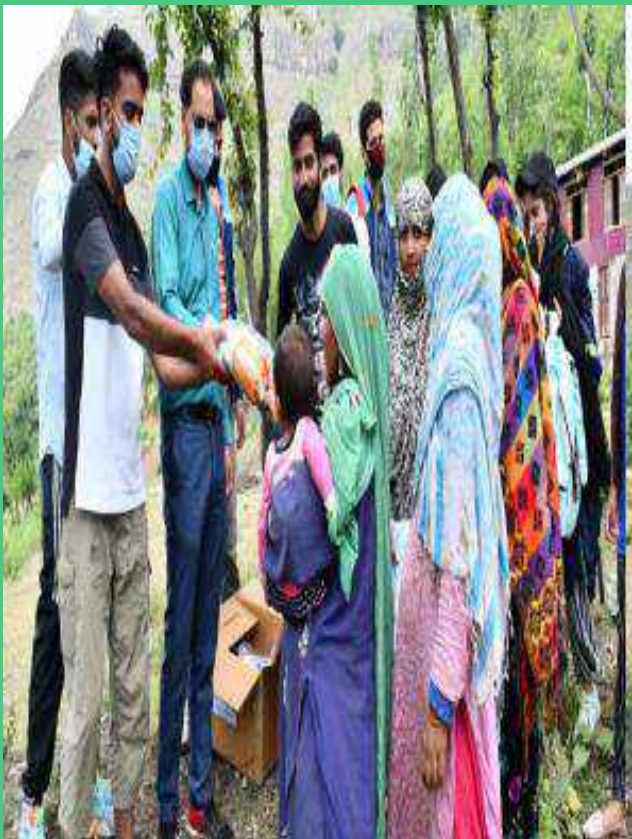

multilingual approach in order to maintain the discipline of virtual meet and to satisfy the cognitive dimension of the students. He highlighted the statistics of suicide of entire world and said that developing countries had become more victim to it. He said that suicide is a major health issue and is considered preventable. While discussing risk factors, he highlighted the risk factors like previous suicide attempts, history of substance abuse, physical disability or illness, losing a friend or family member, bullying behaviour, mental health condition and relationship problems can lead or compel a person to commit suicide. He also said that we should not take warning signs of suicide like, negative self-feeling, hopelessness, feeling alone, irritability, possessing lethal means, feeling like burden to others, frequently talking of death, engaging risky behaviours, making funeral arrangements, giving things away and substance abuse lightly, but shall identify and redress them with a balanced approach. He added that society have to play very important role in suicide prevention by following the techniques of identify and assist, increase help seeking, elective care/treatment, connectedness, life skills and resilience and respond to crisis. While concluding his talk, he invited students for interaction and question answer session. Students raised number of delicate questions and the guest speaker responded to them in a mature way and with satisfying answers. The webinar was concluded by a formal vote of thanks by Convener psychological counseling cell, GDC Pampore, Prof. Shah Lateef. He thank one and all for making this webinar a success.

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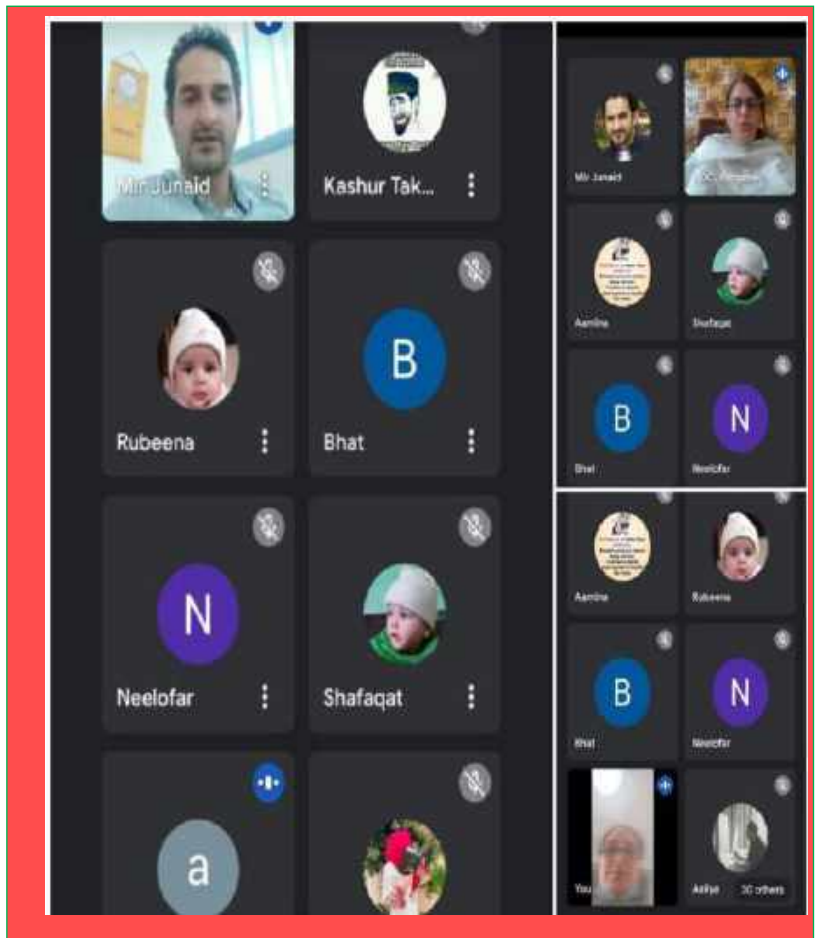

their creativity in any form. They not only made memories while having fun but they were able to face their fears, try new things & realized self-sufficiency. They were

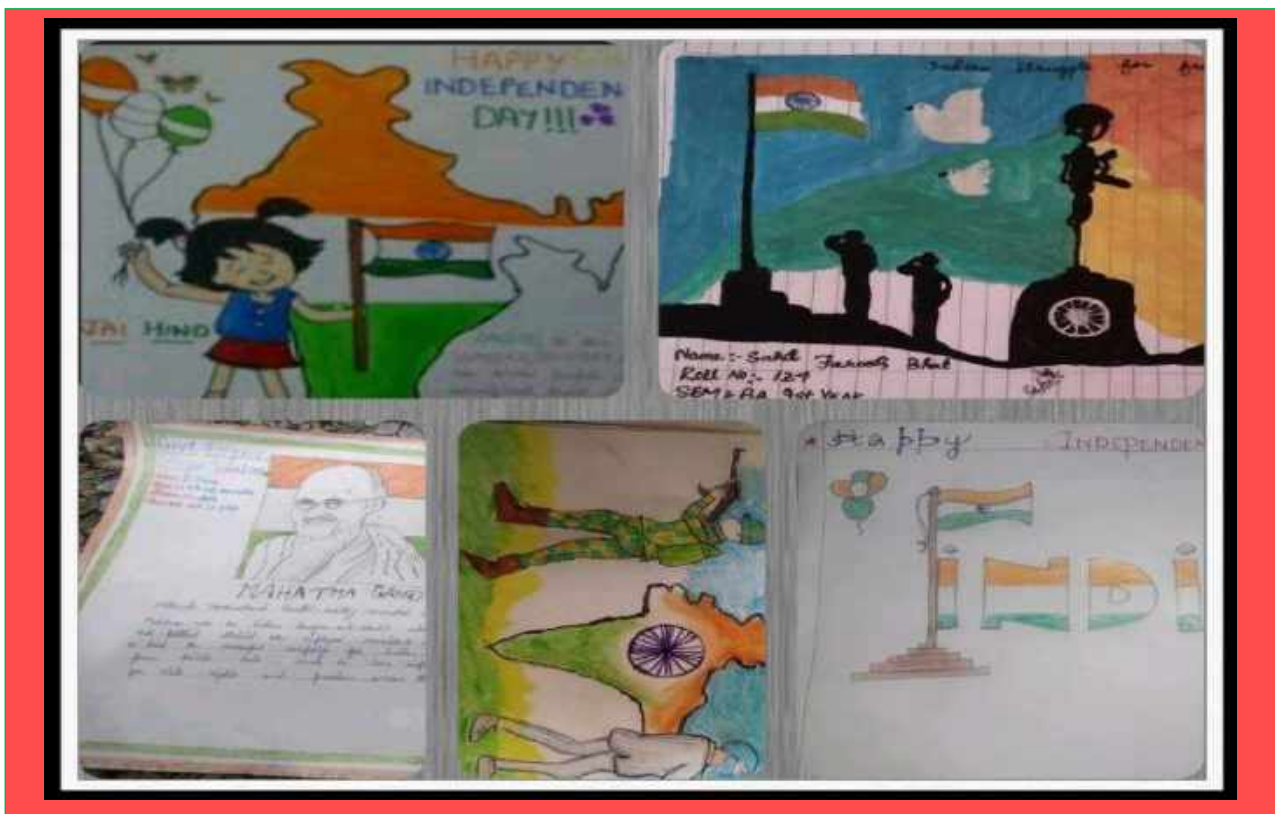

He further maintained that empowering women and raising awareness of women and men on women's rights contributes to limiting the power of gender stereotypes.

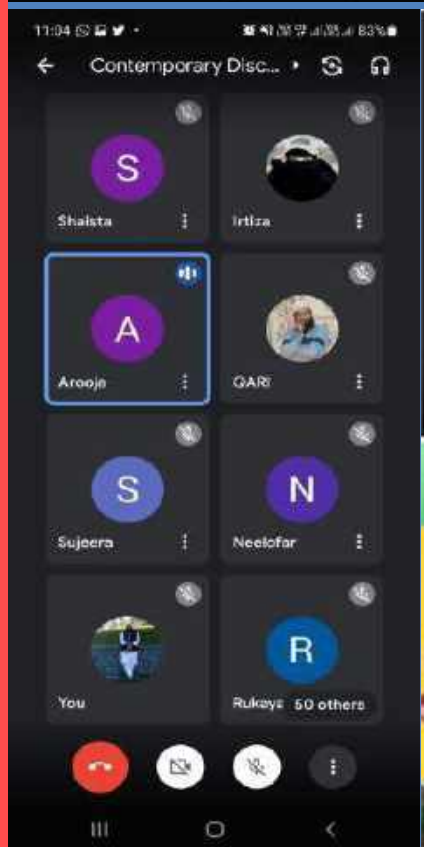
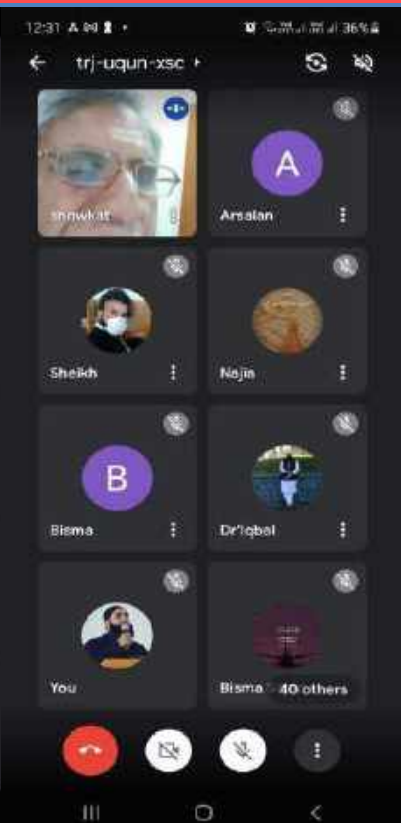
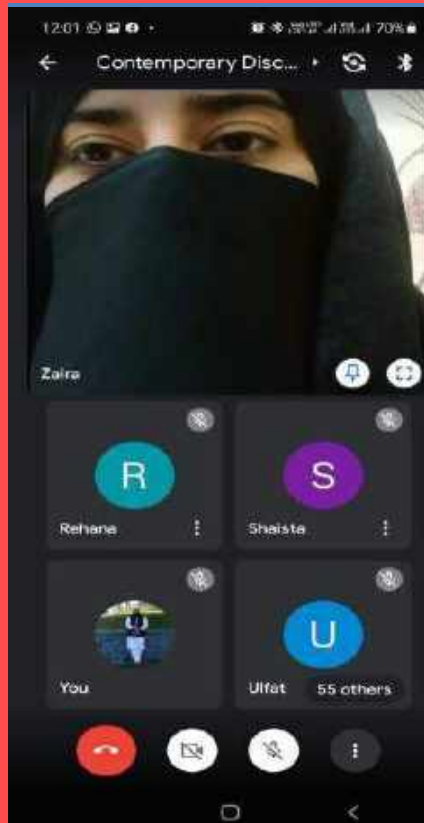
Day 4: Debate “Women Empowerment with Special Reference to Women Leadership (An Islamic Perspective)”

One Day Trekking Programme for Girls to Pahalgam

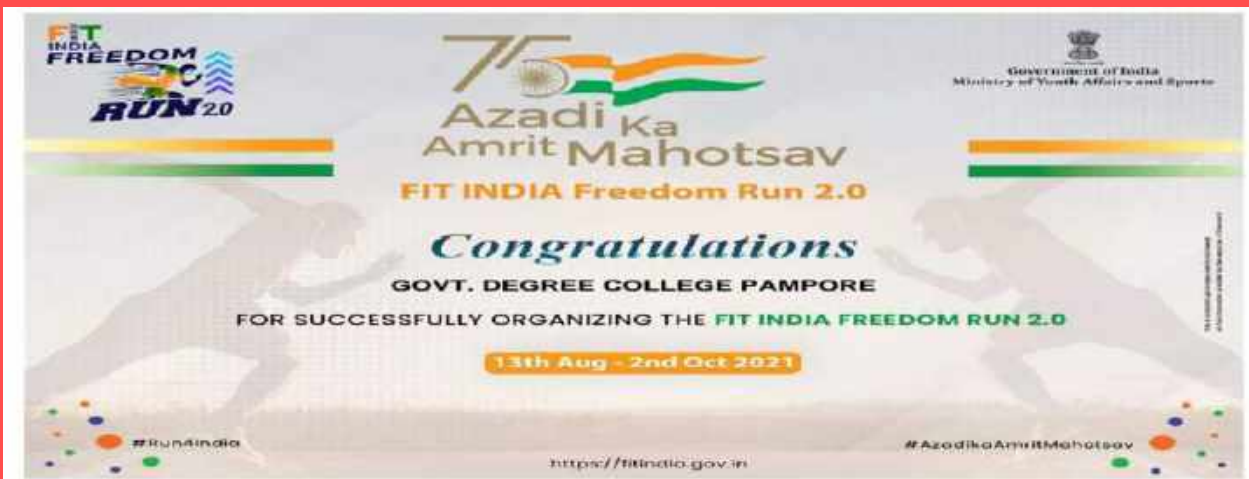
